Fill a jar with 20 things you love or admire about a friend, teacher or family member. Give it to them as a special gift to treasure.

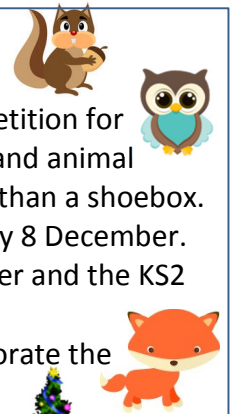

The animals will be used to decorate the Christmas Grotto.

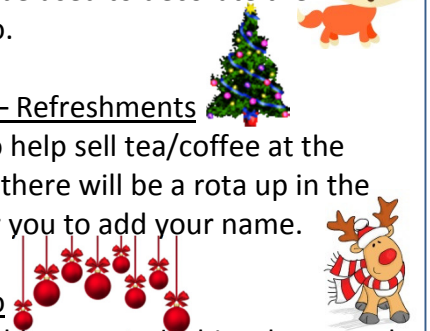


Christmas Plays – Refreshments

If you have any old unwanted white sheets and would like to donate them to a good cause, we need some to use in our grotto.

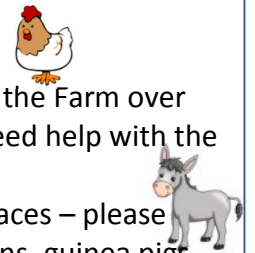


School Farm – Christmas Rota Please Help!
