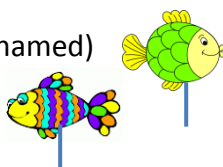
The Friends will be selling refreshments at the Fair and would like donations of nut-free cakes and biscuits.

### PLEASE NOTE - School Grounds

Unfortunately, over the past months we have had needless vandalism in the grounds and teenagers hanging around and smoking. At times, they have caused Mrs Hawkings and her team much extra work to tidy and reorganise. Balls have hit not only our windows, but also neighbours. The fence post and fence has been broken where they have climbed over. School PE equipment has been taken and used.

We have had to once again, involve the police as some of the youths were not known. We spoke to the parents of some who were very supportive. This meant they were not on site when the police did call in and speak to them.

The rule for the grounds out of hours is that an adult needs to be present to supervise. I have told the children that they must only come onto the grounds with a parent or carer, as I would not want any child to be hurt, or be there unsupervised when the police patrol the grounds.

Please can you make sure that if your child is on the grounds, you are there to supervise them and they are playing appropriately and not in fenced areas. The field, trim-trails and playground are fine.

#### After School

Do make sure if you are enjoying the sunshine in the grounds after school that you or somebody else is supervising and watching your child. The children know the rules:

- No child lifts someone onto the monkey bars
- Children must not climb onto the tunnel or the roof areas
- Chase games should be played away from trim tails
- Monkey bars: children must go from same end as others using them

### Eco stall at the Summer Fair

**Come and buy your reusable sandwich wrappers from the Eco Committee for £4 each.**
